HEAD QUESTIONS

- What do you know about the prophet Isaiah? (hint: if you have a study bible you can find some of this info in the introduction)
- Read 2 Chronicles 26. What does this tell us about King Uzziah? Why would this be important to note at the beginning of Isaiah's vision?
- Look at the description of God and his attendants in Isaiah 6. What do you learn about him from these descriptions?



HEART QUESTIONS

- If you had direct access to God, what is something you would want to ask him? Why would you ask that?
- How does your answer to the previous question differ from Isaiah's response to God? Why?
- How is Isaiah saved? What does he do? What does God do? What does this tell us about our salvation?
- Do you think the sequence of events in this passage is important? Why or why not?



HAND QUESTIONS

- How much time do you spend thinking about who God is? How has the scripture informed those thoughts? How has that time affected you?
- What keeps you from sharing with people about God, Jesus, and the gospel? Do you think it's important to share about these things? Why or why not?
- How do you think you overcome those hurdles?
- Who are you praying for this week? Would you share their names with others so you could pray together?
