## HEART QUESTIONS

- What is the message of the servant in Isa 49:1-7? How do you think that relates to you?
- What griefs, sorrows, transgressions, and afflictions do you think the servant carried for you? (cf. Isa 53:4-6)
- How should you respond to someone who has done these things (carried your sins) for you?
